lash extension

MAINTENANCE:

- Clean your lashes regularly with your lash cleanser to avoid oil and dirt build up.
- Avoid oil products around the eye area, since oil breaks down the glue
- Eyeliner, eyeshadow, foundation, etc. are all okay, but no mascara unless specified for lash extensions
- Keep them brushed and neat so that your lashes always look their best and not tangled
- Avoid rubbing, pulling or tugging lashes. Doing so may cause lashes to fall out prematurely
- If and when you find lashes that have come off of your eye, it is normal to see your natural lash attached to the extension.
 Don't worry, the extensions are not making your natural lashes fall out, you are just shedding
- ∧ Always remember, clean lashes are happy lashes ☺

FILLS:

- If it's been 2-3 weeks it is time for a fill, but ultimately it is up to you when you would like to come in
- We have a standard fill option or an extended fill option for those who waited a little too long to get their fill, or for those who just want an extra 30m of lashing
- Coming in with clean lashes ensures you get the time you need for your fill. When lashes aren't clean, it may take time away from your service due to the tech having to work around build up
- Clean lashes with cleanser day of fill. Doing so will help glue adhere better to your natural lash.
